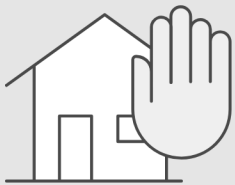


WHEN TO CANCEL YOUR VISIT

GUIDELINES

With cold, flu, RSV, and stomach virus season upon us, we would like to provide some guidelines regarding cancelling appointments and when to keep your child home from playgroup.

KEEP YOUR CHILD HOME/CANCEL IF....



The child or anyone in the house has vomited or had diarrhea in the last 24 hours

The child or anyone in the house has a fever over 100.3 F in the last 24 hours

The child or anyone in the house has an unexplained cough or runny nose

The child or anyone in the house has pink eye

The child has an undiagnosed rash, other than diaper rash

If the child or anyone in the house has any COVID symptoms, is awaiting a COVID test, or has tested positive for COVID.

WHEN TO RESUME APPOINTMENTS

When your child and your family can pass the daily health screening.

Please check with your service coordinator/provider about when visits can resume.



SYMPTOMS CHECKLIST

- ✓ has my child or any member of the household had a fever over 100.3 F or higher in the past 24 hours without fever reducing medication?
- ✓ does my child or anyone else in my household have a new cough, sore throat, headache, shortness of breath, runny nose/congestion not consistent with allergies; chills or muscle aches, nausea vomiting or diarrhea, or loss of taste or smell in the last 24 hours?
- ✓ does my child or any member of my household have any other COVID symptoms, a positive COVID test, or is awaiting COVID test results?
